For the past 10 years Anna (the pastor's wife) has coordinated kids ministry at Calvary Waterford, however she returned to college in September and increased her hours at work to support their family. I took over coordinating Kids Ministry in September.

I have been loving getting to know the kids and leaders, and I've been so encouraged to see enthusiasm and growth in the kids. I didn't realise how much I missed kid's ministry. Our kids come from diverse backgrounds, family situations, cultures and with a variety of needs... and they are wonderful. I have found the role very stretching and am increasingly aware that my capacity is reduced, but God has been beautifully ministering to me in the midst of weakness and imperfection and showing me the strength that there is in turning to him in my inability. His grace is sufficient. Our leaders are also very diverse, and facing many trials and difficulties, that I find overwhelming at times. However, I am learning so much from them, especially hearing them speak of God's goodness and care in the midst of trials.

I am continuing to work as an Occupational Therapist, and we are in another period of short staffing. I often feel over-stretched and unable to do all that is needed. I am grateful to God for those moments when He prompts me to cry out to Him, rather than looking within or despairing. I am so grateful for all of these reminders that I am dust, and that I am dependent on our Heavenly Father.

- That the kids at church would grow to know and love Jesus more and more:
- That God would enable us as leaders to love each child wisely and well;
- That God would enable me to do the preparation needed to assist the leaders, especially for over the Christmas period when I will be away;
